About "Kodomoen"

A Kodomoen is a school consisting of both a Yochien (Kindergarten & Preschool) and a Hoikuen (Nursery School).

Our students in the Kodomoen consist of ages six months (conference needed before acceptance) until six years.

The Hoikuen accepts students age 0-2 for dual-working families. Once the student turns three, parents may choose to enroll them in Yochien. Families of one working parent may be able to enroll once their student turns three.

About New System & Family Categories

There are three categories in which your family can fall into.

O <u>Category 1</u>

For students enrolling at age 3-5 years and only **one** parent works, they can enroll at Yochien.

O Category 2

For students enrolling at age 3-5 years and <u>**both**</u> parents work, they can enroll at Hoikuen or Yochien.

O <u>Category 3</u>

For students enrolling at age 0-2 years and **both** parents work, they can enroll at Hoikuen.

* Can enroll the month after their birth month (ex. A May birthday equals a June start date).

X Whether a dual-working family is eligible for Category 2 or 3 depends on the amount of hours each parent works during a month. For these two categories, standard time (11 hours of care) is available for families where both parents work over 120 hours per month, and short time (8 hours of care) is available for families where one or both parents work 48-119 hours per month.

Team Thinking

Students age 3+ in Category 1 (Yochien) and Category 2 (Hoikuen) do to the same program together even though they are registered in different portions of the Kodomoen depending on their parents working status.



About Long Holidays (Category 1)

· Special Care during Summer, Spring, and Winter holidays is available for Categories 2 & 3 automatically at no extra charge, and for Category 1 for a fee and with additional paperwork submitted ahead of time.

• There is no bus service on Special Care, so drop off and pick up by parents are required.

Pickup/Drop off

- Bus Courses

- * Bus stop time varies for pickup (8:00~9:30) & drop off (14:30~16:00)
- * Our courses include Main Base, Atago Hills, and two areas in town.
- * Bus fee is ¥2,000 per month for two ways.
- * During long holidays we have no bus service.
- * Bus service is available for students of Categories 1 & 2 only.

- Walking Courses

- * Walking course pickup is at 8:30, and we leave the school at 15:20
- * We have two walking courses in the School`s neighborhood

PTO (Parent & Teachers Organization)

- All children benefit from PTO services and <u>ALL PARENTS</u> are a part of the PTO.
- PTO incorporates parents of both Iwakuni Kawashimo Yochien and Apple Tree Hoikuen.

• Staff members select a group of parents to lead the PTO, but all parents help prepare for some special events, make plans, and organize fellow parents.

• All parents must help with at least two school events per year at two events per family (ex. Sports Day, Arts Festival, Recital, etc.).

• The above applies to parents of Category 3 students except that these parents do not need to be a leader of the PTO.

Hoshi Class Graduation Fee

The cost of all uniforms comes to about ¥40,000.

- * Category 3 does not need to buy school uniforms.
- * Students age 2 need to buy smock and backpack, about ¥9,000
- * Supply & uniform fees should be paid at Yochien or Hoikuen orientation day.
- * You will receive your items by the end of March.

All students are required to eat school lunch. Our

Other Information

English Conversation

English teachers come everyday to teach in native English. American teachers teach common English songs, read books, and provide English lessons. We have Kawashimo English Club every Friday afternoon. We have many English-speaking and American staff members to assist with parent communications.

Gymnastics (PE)

Twice a month a professional physical education teacher teaches students to exercise and play sports and games as a team.

Rhythmics (Music)

Every Tuesday a professional rhythmics teacher teaches students to express themselves and understand rhythm.

Legal Matters

It is the policy of the Yochien that if a parent initiates a legal dispute against the school, the child will not attend the school until the legal matter is resolved.








History
